Monday 1/22	<b>PROMPT #1</b> Good readers make comparisons. Use this diagram to explore how two characters are alike and different.
Tuesday 1/23	<b>PROMPT #2</b> Problem kick-off: What is the problem in the story? How does it start? Write a paragraph explain what started the problem and how is it being worked out.
Wednesday 1/24	<b>PROMPT #3</b> Fold tonight's reading response sheet in half horizontally. Choose a character from the book you are reading. On the left side of the page, describe the character at the beginning of the story. On the right, describe how the character is changing as the story progresses.
Thursday 1/25	<b>BREAK NIGHT</b> Review your log. Check for spelling and sentence structure. Do your responses address the prompt?
Friday 1/26	<b>PROMPT #4</b> Design a trophy. Inside the trophy explain at least three reasons your book is a winner. Color your trophy.
Weekend 1/27 - 1/28	<b>PROMPT #5</b> Readers often make connections between the text they are reading and something that is happening or has happened in the world. The text might be a newspaper or magazine article, an informational text about a specific topic or event, or a story on the television or radio. As you read, think about the text-to-world connection that you are making. How are the events in this story similar to things that happen in the real world? Please complete this entry on the sheet in your binder.
