<b>Tuesday</b> <b>10/10</b>	<p>Create a slogan for your book. Something catchy, that represents the theme of the story, or the message the author is trying to send to the reader. Make it colorful and explain in detail why you chose the slogan that you did. <b>Wednesday</b> <b>10/11</b>	<p>What came as a surprise in the story? Write a paragraph about what surprised you and why. <b>Thursday</b> <b>10/12</b>	<p>Try to read an entire chapter tonight.
